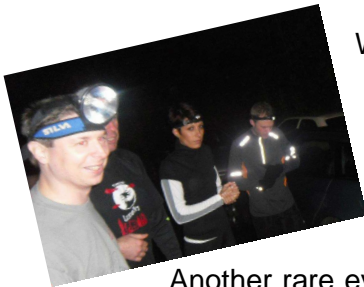

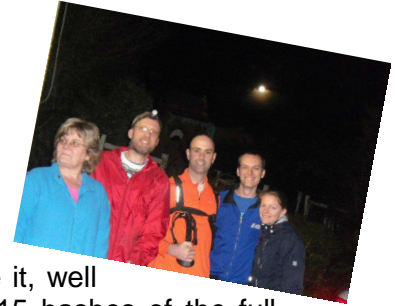
Trail: Bittaford

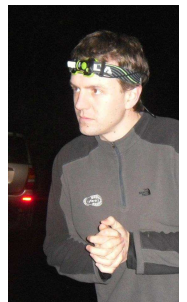
Another rare event took place before the Hash, **Peanut** was seen *passing an open pub*. So eventful was this, another great photo was taken.
